



# Aircraft Rental Contract

**Rental agreement is to be considered in use any time a pilot, student pilot or any other person is using an Aeropro aircraft, without an authorized Aeropro instructor on board.**

- Rental rates are based on the Hobbs meter time and due immediately following the rental period. Rates include fuel and oil. Save all fuel receipts and attach to your payments invoice. Reimbursement will be at Aeropro current rate of cost.
- A current credit card or pre-purchased block time must be on file with Aeropro to rent aircraft. We accept Master Card, Visa and American Express. Payment may also be made by check or cash.
- There is a **three hours per day minimum charge** for aircraft reserved **all day or overnight**.
- Failure to give at least 12 hours' notice of cancellation before scheduled departure time may result in a charge to the renter of up to half of reserved rental time. Exceptions will be made on a case-by-case basis. Failure of a renter to show within 15 minutes after the time the flight was scheduled effectively cancels their flights and leaves the aircraft open for anyone to use during that time.
- Same-day cancellations of a scheduled lesson will be subject to a charge of instructor fee for the total lesson time to the renter/student on the second occurrence. Exceptions will be made for weather and on a case-by-case basis.
- Anyone renting Aeropro aircraft must be in compliance with all FAA regulations. It is the renter's responsibility to determine if they are legal in all respects to operate rental aircraft; in terms not limited to appropriate and current medical certificate, pilot's license, flight review, 90 days currency, and any required logbook endorsements. Flight instructors shall ensure their students are in compliance with this provision at the time of checkout.
- Flight instruction in Aeropro aircraft may be given only by Aeropro flight instructors. Aircraft may not be rented to give flight instruction.
- Rental pilots must have flown Aeropro aircraft within the last 90 days to continue renting. If not, they must complete another checkout with an approved flight instructor. In addition, they must be current in each make and model aircraft they desire to fly.
- Flights outside the continental United States are not permitted.
- The renter agrees to report to Aeropro any accident, mishap, incident or physical damage to any person or to the aircraft as soon as possible and will be responsible for the cost of damage through the insurance policy required by Aeropro. If a policy has lapsed or is not in place the renter will be liable for the full cost to replace or repair the aircraft.
- The aircraft will not be used to carry persons or property for hire, or flown in any race, contest, or be used to perform aerobatics or spins.
- All renters are required to have a renter's insurance policy with AT LEAST \$5,000 of aircraft damage liability coverage.
